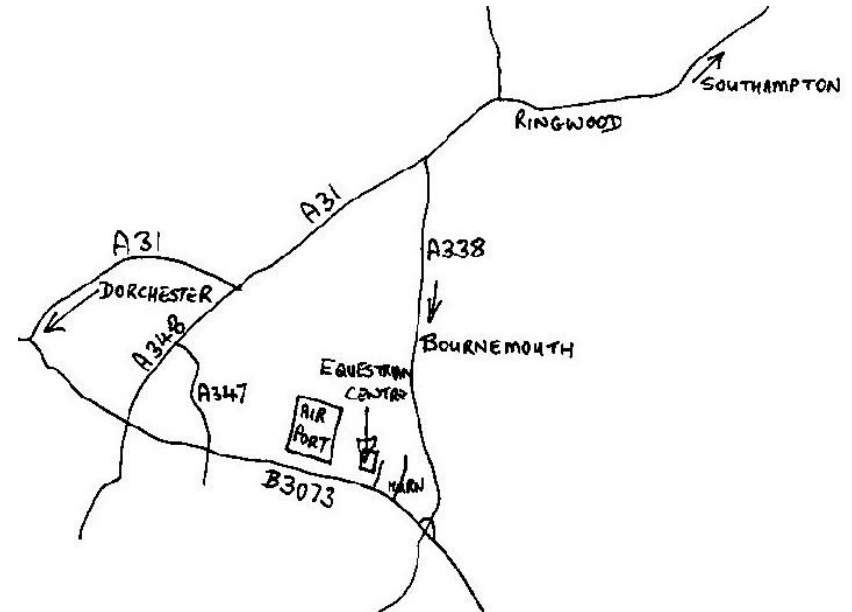

Directions

Hurn Bridge Equestrian Centre is just to the east of Bournemouth Airport on the B3073. The airport is clearly signposted from the A31.

From all directions, head to Ringwood on the A31. Take the Bournemouth (A338) road at the interchange west of Ringwood. At the first exit (5 miles) turn onto the B3073 towards Bournemouth Airport. Go straight across the traffic lights, at the mini roundabout take the first exit. The entrance to the equestrian centre is about 150 yards on the right-hand side. DO NOT ENTER THE YARD but proceed up the lane where you will find the entrance to the show field on the left.



Please keep all dogs on leads & clear hay & droppings from car/lorry park before leaving the show - Thanks.

In Hand

Class 1 Fell Stallions 4 years and over.

Class 2 Fell Mares 4yrs & over.

Class 3 Fell Geldings 4yrs & over.

Class 4 Dales Mares 4yrs& over.

Class 5 Fell Youngstock, yearlings, 2 & 3 year old Filly or Gelding.
Rosettes for best yearling, 2 year old and 3 year old.

Class 6 Fell Youngstock, Colts aged 2 or 3.
Rosette for best 2 year old and 3 year old.

Class 7 Dales Stallions 2yrs and over, Geldings 4yrs and over.

Class 8 Fell Veterans 15yrs & over

Class 9 Dales Youngstock, yearlings, 2 & 3 year old Filly or Gelding.

Class 10 Fell and Dales potential driving pony. MUST be shown in hand, no long reining.

Dales In Hand Championship for 1st & 2nd places classes 4,7,9.

A special/performance rosette is offered by the dales pony society for the best registered dales pony shown by an exhibitor who produces a current membership card in the ring.

Fell Youngstock Championship for 1st & 2nd places classes 5,6.

Fell In Hand Championship for 1st & 2nd places classes 1,2,3,8, Fell youngstock champion/reserve.

The highest placed South West member in the In Hand Championship will qualify for the Inter Area Championship at the Southern Show.

1 Hour Break - the arena may be used for warming up for ridden classes.

Ridden

Class 11 Fell Novice Ridden – pony not to have been placed in any ridden class (with 4 or more entries) in the last 2 seasons.

Class 12 Fell Stallions

Class 13 Fell Mares

Class 14 Fell Geldings

Class 15 Dales Stallions, Mares and Geldings

Class 16 Fell Veterans 15yrs & over

Class 17 Dales Stallions, Mares and Geldings Traditional Ridden class – walk and trot only.

Class 18 Fell Stallions & Geldings Traditional Ridden class – walk and trot only.

Class 19 Fell Mares Traditional Ridden class – walk and trot only.

Dales Ridden Championship for 1st & 2nd places classes 15,17.

A special/performance rosette is offered by the dales pony society for the best registered dales pony shown by an exhibitor who produces a current membership card in the ring.

Dales Supreme Championship for In Hand and Ridden Champion & Reserve

Fell Ridden Championship for 1st & 2nd places classes 11,12,13, 14,16,18,19.

Fell Supreme Championship for In Hand and Ridden Champion & Reserve

Dressage Fells and Dales

Class 20 Walk and Trot 2019 (Test available on website).

Class 21 BD Intro C / Prelim 14(2006). Results will be taken from Percentage. You may ride both tests but you must pay for each test.

RULES – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Fell Pony Society Showing rules will apply. In addition:

1. The Fell Pony Society / Dales Pony Society do not accept liability for any loss of property or any accident or damage to any animal, vehicle, spectator or exhibitor, and all the entries are accepted subject to this condition.
2. All exhibitors entering must be a fully paid member of the Fell Pony Society and/or the Dales Pony Society.
3. All ponies must be registered with the Fell Pony Society / Dales Pony Society.
4. Riders must wear a riding hat that complies with the current safety standard.
5. Fell ponies must not exceed 14hh. Judges are at liberty to request a pony to be measured. JMB certificates will be accepted - pony and certificate must be presented to the judge.
- 6. Exhibitors should not enter classes judged by their pony's breeder or family.**
7. Ponies need not be vaccinated against Equine Flu, but any pony showing signs of coughing, or any virus complaint, will be asked to leave the show field
8. **Entries close 29th April 2019 – STRICTLY NO LATE ENTRIES.**
9. Ponies may only be entered once in any class except class 21.
10. Entry fee £5.50 per class.
11. Entry fees will not be refunded.
12. Complaints - to be made in writing with a fee of £20 (will be refunded if complaint upheld).
13. Competitors must wear their correct number while in the rings.
14. FPS / DPS membership number **MUST** be stated on entry form.
15. Dales entries only - It is the responsibility of every exhibitor to ensure that all riders, and handlers are fully paid up members of the Society. This is for insurance purposes.

NOTES

1. The judge may ask for ponies to be stripped in ridden classes.
2. Class 18 & 19 will be combined if low entries.
3. Classes 20 & 21 - These classes will start with the Walk & Trot at 12.30pm and will run until 2.30pm. Times will be given to competitors for their test(s), these will be published on the web prior to the show and will be available from the secretaries tent on the day. Please try to be ready to enter the arena at the stated time. Times may be adjusted on the day if the showing classes over run.
